How much time should my child be spending daily on school work?

<p>Approximate daily time a student should spend in Zoom or watching instructional videos</p> <p><i>These times might vary based on an individual student's program and services, but this gives you a general idea of our expectations.</i></p>	Preschool	30 minutes
	Early Years - K/1	45 min. - 1 hour
	Primary Years - 2/3	45 min. - 1 1/2 hours
	Intermediate Years - 4/5	1 hour - 1 1/2 hours
	Middle School - 6-8	1 1/2 hours - 2 1/2 hours
<p>Generally, the minimum daily time students should spend working on assignments, daily reading, and practice utilizing online platforms/programs</p>	Preschool	20 minutes
	Early Years - K/1	1 hour
	Primary Years - 2/3	1 1/4 hours
	Intermediate Years - 4/5	1 1/2 hours
	Middle School - 6-8	2 hours

How will my child be graded during this time of distance learning?

K-5 will receive participation/limited participation/no participation marks for grading period.
6-8 will receive credit or no-credit marks for grading period/assignments.
