
Movie Poster Book Report

The Director	The director name is given with correct capitalization and spelling. (This is you!)	/10
Synopsis	A short synopsis is give to explain what your book and movie is about. Correct spelling and capitalization are used. The synopsis is written in complete sentences.	/20
Picture	A detailed and colored picture or pictures of your book are shown.	/20
Neatness	The poster is neat and legible and done on poster board	/10
Creativity	The poster is creative and the director used their imagination	/10
